A Neuroradiologist is a subspecialized diagnostic radiologist. These specialists focus on diagnosing and characterizing abnormalities of the central and peripheral nervous system, spine and head and neck. Primarily, the imaging modalities used in this subspecialty are CT (Computed Tomography) and MRI (Magnetic Resonance Imaging) scans. Neuroradiologist complete diagnostic radiology residency, followed by a one or two year program focused directly on this area of interest.
